Who can apply?

You can apply for a Dales Railcard if you are 16-years-old and over and live between:

- Skipton and Carlisle (on the Leeds-Settle-Appleby-Carlisle line)
- Skipton and Carnforth (on the Bentham line between Leeds, Lancaster and Morecambe)
- Carlisle and Brampton (on the Hadrian's Wall line) and your postcode is in one of the following areas:
 - CA 1, 2, 3, 4, 6, 8, 9, 10, 11, 16, 17
 - DL 8, 11, 12
 - LA 2, 5, 6, 10
 - BD 23, 24
 - BB 7

Where can I use it?

You can use a Dales Railcard to save money on single; day return and period return tickets. Travel validity is between all stations shown on the map, (plus Brampton and Wetheral on the Hadrians Wall line) and from Clitheroe/Whalley to Hellifield (Sundays only). It cannot be used exclusively within the Leeds/Bradford Skipton area or exclusively between Carnforth, Lancaster, Bare Lane and Morecambe.

How much does it cost?

The Dales Railcard costs £13 per person. It is not transferable and can only be used by the person named on the railcard.

How much can I save?

You save 1/3rd on the cost of Single, Day Return and Standard Open Return tickets between valid stations.



What about children?

Up to four children (ages 5 to 15 inclusive) can travel with a railcard holder and the child fare is based on a 81% discount on the adult fare. There is a minimum child fare of £1.

How long is the Dales Railcard valid?

Dales Railcards are valid for 12 months from the date of issue or commencement date.

Are there any other benefits?

Dales Railcard holders will be able to take advantage of the annual winter offer when you will be able to travel the routes for a specially reduced fare. Occasionally other special offers are made available to Dales Railcard holders.

Every effort is made to advise Dales Railcard holders of any special offers by post or email. Alternatively, details of any special offers can be found at scrdc.co.uk, where you can sign up to keep you updated with all the relevant news and offers.

We won't pass your email address to anyone else.

How do I apply for the first time or renew an existing card?

Complete the form overleaf and take it to Appleby, Carlisle, Settle, Skipton, or Carnforth railway stations with proof of your address and identity (eg driving licence or a utilities bill).

Alternatively, scan the QR code or visit scrdc.co.uk/shop where you can buy Dales Railcards online. Please allow seven days for the card to be processed and delivered to you.

You can apply up to one month in advance for a renewal Dales Railcard.

Do you live outside the eligible postcodes?
